Free Baggage Allowance from/to the Canada

- First & Business Class : 2 pieces each not to exceed 62 inches/158 cm. Maximum weight 70lbs/32 kg each.
- Economy Class: 2 pieces each not to exceed 62 inches/158 cm. Maximum weight 50 lbs/23 kg each

* Baggage allowance for tickets issued effective 12th November up to 30th November 2020

- First & Business Class : 3 pieces each not to exceed 62 inches/158cm. Maximumweight70lbs/32 kg eachh.
- Economy Class: 2 pieces each not to exceed 62 inches/158cm. Maximum weight 50 lbs/32 kg each

Combined dimensions of 2 pieces (length + width + height) not to exceed 107inches/ 273 cm, provided neither piece exceeds 62 inches/ 158cm

- One (1) additional piece not to exceed 50 lbs / 23 kg for AI Maharajah Club / AI Golden Edge Club/ AI Silver Edge Club/ Star Alliance Gold members.
- Carry-on baggage: Air India permits one (1) piece of carry-on baggage not to exceed 8 inches/20cm x 16 inches/40cm x 22 inches/55cm and 18 lbs/8 kg, plus one personal item.
